Deacon Ordination & Installation

Pattie Herbert, Beverly Hill, Jeanne Murphy, and Michael Whitenton will be ordained as deacons on Sunday.

Rick Allen, Barbara Hobbs, and Andy Powell,,

who have previously been ordained, will be installed for three-year terms as deacons.

Rick Allen and his wife, Pam, joined Lake Shore in 1982 and raised their children, Nathan and Hannah, here. Now they both have careers in Austin. As for Rick's participation and involvement in Lake Shore, there are few aspects of church life that have not had Rick's hands on them. From being a Sunday School teacher, to a three-time active deacon, to Rite-13 leader, to Young Adults in the Church (YAC) leader, to youth pilgrimage participant, to Children's Center Board president, to the Hansma Peace Garden, Rick has been fully involved in the church and its growth. He has even preached a couple of times, and he certainly cares about the natural environment surrounding our building. We are proud to have Rick's wisdom, experience, and insight once again on our diaconate. When asked to give his views on being part of Lake Shore, Rick responded, "I love all of God's children and am so blessed to be a member of Lake Shore".

Pattie Herbert is well-known to those Lake Shore parents who have had children in the nursery over the years. She joined Lake Shore in 2001, having first come to Lake Shore in 1988, Pattie worked in the Children's Center, and for 21 years she was our Church Custodian. Pattie has been actively engaged in a number of our mission projects including Meals on Wheels, the board for Shalom Children' Center, and Bridge Builders and Helping Hands. Pattie was part of each mission trip to work at God's Love We Deliver in New York City. She made two trips to Ghana to see first-hand all the wonderful things happening at Shalom and came back with a wonderful slide show. Pattie's family includes two sons, Taylor who lives with his wife and daughter in Austin, and Austin who lives with his wife and son here in Waco. We are pleased to have Pattie serve our church in this new capacity.

Beverly Hill and Dennis joined Lake Shore 48 years ago. Their daughters grew up here, and both were married by Roger Paynter. Beverly has had a long and strong connection to many of Lake Shore's programs and served as the director at the Children's Center from 1969 to 1980 the time when the Children's Center began. Presently, Beverly serves on the Children's Center Board, a role in which she has served several

times over the years. She is a member of the Awesome Blossom Sunday School class. Her Friday mornings are fully filled by coordinating the Meals and Wheels deliveries from our kitchen. Beverly and Dennis' daughters, Holly and Kellie, both live in Abilene.

Barbara Hobbs, and her husband, Willie, joined Lake Shore Baptist in 1991. During her time here, Barbara has been committed to Meals on Wheels. She served as a Site Manager for nine years and as a Coordinator until 2011. Additionally, she has Co-chaired the Fellowship Committee and the Committee Coordinating Council. She served on the deacon executive committee several times. For years, Barbara and Willie have volunteered with the Family Self-Sufficiency program. She is a faithful volunteer in the church office whenever we need her. For the past several years, Barbara has come on Saturdays and again early on Sunday mornings to prepare things for communion and make sure everything is ready at the table for the meal. Barbara has accrued lots of experience as an usher, and you'll see her at the back door many Sunday mornings and at most memorial services.

Jeanne Murphy first attended Lake Shore in the fall of 2008, when she and Isabelle moved to Waco from Boone, North Carolina. By the time she became a member in the spring of 2010, Walt had moved to join them, and they were regularly attending the Bereshith Sunday School class. Since then, she has been on the search committee that called Jaime as children's minister, served on the children's education committee, was a member of Zach's site team, and volunteered for food pantry and family self-sufficiency. Jeanne enjoys baking, and periodically provides desserts for Wednesday night suppers and other events. Numerous Lake Shore members know her for her decorated sugar cookies or Texas sheet cake. Jeanne and Walt are currently on the youth education committee, and she serves as the social director for the Bereshith S.S. class.
