New Online Church Directory This Spring

We are updating the church website this spring. Part of the plan is to include an online church directory of our active, resident community.

The directory will be password protected, and it will be accessible only to people who are listed in it. If you opt in, you will be able to access it on your desktop/notebook, your tablet, and your phone, and we will also be able to produce a printed version. You will be able to add new cell phone numbers, new email addresses, new family members' information at any time.

A first step in creating the online directory is making sure all the contact information we already have on file in the office is up-to-date. During the coming week, we will send everyone in the active, resident community an email that includes an attachment of the current printed directory. Please open the attachment to check your current contact information.

You can help us by sending a return email that includes your answers to two questions:

1. Is your contact information correct?
"yes" or "no" (if "no," then send correction)
2. Do you want to be included in the online directory? "yes" or "no"

If you opt out of the online directory, we would still like to have your correct contact information here in the office.

We hope that the new pictorial directory will help all of us (and especially new folks) to get acquainted more easily. You will be able to submit pictures of yourselves for the directory, but we will also provide an opportunity for you to have your picture taken, free of charge, by other church members. More information about photo submissions and photo sessions will follow in future newsletters.
