As Congress works on the 2018 and spending bills, I ask you to make funding decisions that will put us on track to end hunger by 2030. I urge you to adequately invest in programs like WIC, SNAP, tax credits for lowincome workers, and Meals on Wheels. These programs are helping millions of people escape from hunger. We have made great progress reducing hunger and poverty in our country and around the world, but our work remains unfinished. My faith calls me to urge you to make public investments that will reduce and perhaps end hunger.


Sharing a Little Cool Breeze
