Solar Panels Up and Running!

On May 17, Lake Shore Baptist approved a plan to radically reduce its electric power consumption. A few years earlier, we replaced old, inefficient windows on the rear of the building with insulated units. Under the new plan, we agreed on three more additional investments: (1) install an



array of 140 solar panels on the roof, reducing the power bill by about \$6,000/year; (2) install high-efficiency Mitsubishi heat pumps in the office area and Children’s Center, allowing us to dial back heating/cooling in the sanctuary, hallways, and other classrooms; and (3) install 142 LED fixtures, each consuming 74% less power than the florescent panels they replace. Installation of the solar panels was completed by Freedom Solar of Austin on Saturday. They are up and running!

Thanks to Skip Londos who originally proposed the idea of solar panels two years ago and to Bruce Neatherlin, who started working on the project as chair of Buildings and Grounds. Compliments to David Mosley and other members of our Building and Grounds and Finance committees who formulated the full proposal, presented it to the church, and have been carrying it to completion.
