Prayer of Protest

Kyndall led us in this prayer Sunday, August 6.

The following prayer is a collection of questions and statements of struggle I gathered from the Lake Shore youth. They expressed to me some of the things they wonder about during their wrestling matches with God. These are their words, not mine, and yet, I recognize these questions as my own. I resonate with the struggle they articulate, and I wouldn't be surprised if you did too. So let us pray together, joining our hearts to theirs, and in the spirit of Psalmist, may we be unreservedly blunt with God. Periodically I will quote from Psalm 17, and I invite you to join me such that when I pray, "Hear a just cause, O Lord, attend to my cry," you will respond, "Give ear to my prayer." Let us pray.

O God, listen now to the prayers of our youth, the prayers of our most honest selves, the prayers of our unfiltered raw energy. Hear a just cause, O Lord; attend to my cry! And the people prayed, **Give ear to my prayer!**

Sometimes I wonder why it feels like God doesn't listen. Sometimes I'm angry at God because there are starving people in the world.

Sometimes I'm angry at God because people care so little about our planet.

I get angry at God because life is unfair.

Hear a just cause, O Lord; attend to my cry. And the people prayed: **Give ear to my prayer!**

Sometimes I wonder why I am where I am. Sometimes I wonder why doing terrible things is part of God's plan.

Sometimes I wonder why and how we can so easily forgive God for hurting us.

Why do some of us suffer in sickness and our health?

Hear a just cause, O Lord; attend to my cry. And the people cried: **Give ear to my prayer!**

Why is there world hunger, pollution, murder and crimes, and child abuse?

Why does our world carry child molesters?

Why does she have to keep hurting?

Why don't we count as people?

Hear a just cause, O Lord; attend to my cry. And the people begged: **Give ear to my prayer!**

In the words of the Psalmist: "From you, let my vindication come, O God! Let your eyes see the right."

God, do you see what I'm seeing? Hear a just cause, O Lord; attend to my cry. And the people said again: **Give ear to my prayer!**

In the words of the Psalmist: "From you, let my vindication come, O God! Let your eyes see the right. I will call upon you, for you will answer me, O God; incline your ear to me. Hear my words. Wondrously show your steadfast love, O Savior of those who seek refuge from their adversaries at your right hand."

John Gervais broke his ankle in two places when he fell. He will likely need surgery. Pray for him and Kelly and their boys.


