MISSIONS TREE

A week ago today, there were 150 angel ornaments and mission projects on the tree. Today half of the projects have been selected and some have already been fulfilled.



If you haven't selected a mission activity yet, or would like another, here are some ideas of projects still on the tree:

- Purchase a board game for teenagers living temporarily at the Family Abuse Center.
- Give Fisher Price Little People and animal figures for the children at LSBCC.
- Purchase a large package of size large Depends Pull-Up for a male MOW client.
- Put together 2 hygiene kits for Mission Waco's Meyer Center to distribute to homeless women.
- Give various sizes of kids' playground balls for the children at the Talitha Koum Institute.
- Provide a Bible for a new Waco Habitat homeowner family.
- Give a \$30 UPS or Office Depot gift card to the Waco Immigration Alliance to enable the organization to print or make copies or to purchase office supplies.
- Provide multi-packs of microwaveable mac & cheese, soup, and ramen for the homeless teens who study and eat at The Cove.
- Give \$50 or more to repair the roof on Nsam Baptist Church.
- Give a \$50 Home Depot or Lowe's gift card to purchase three buckets of All Purpose 4.5 gal. Pre-Mixed Joint Compound to be used for Hurricane Harvey repair and recovery work in Houston.
- Give \$20 or more to provide shoe boxes (\$10 each) containing a small toy, toothbrush & toothpaste, pencils, crayons, etc. to distribute to Syrian refugee children in Turkey.
- Give \$50 to purchase five hymnals for the new church that Casey and Brittany are helping to start in Chengdu.
- Provide funds to purchase handmade school uniforms (\$12 each) for the students at Shalom Children's Center in Ghana.
- Give \$50 or more to support Mission Waco/Mission World Women's Micro Credit program.
- Give \$50 or more to help the LSESD provide a Christmas meal event for Syrian refugee children at a church in the Anjar, Bekaa region, Lebanon.

Honor Horn, who is at The Healthcare Resort near Hillcrest for rehab, following her stroke.


Barbara Tucker's mother who has bladder cancer.


