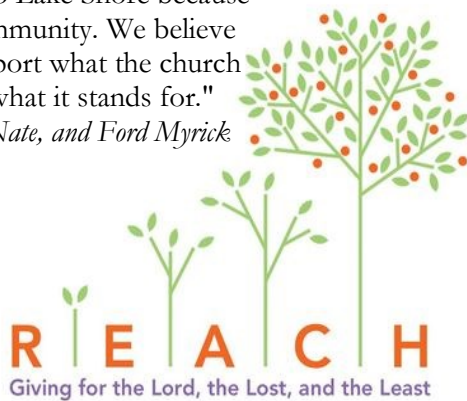

### Fall at the Farm was a success!

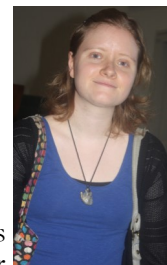

## Operation Christmas Child



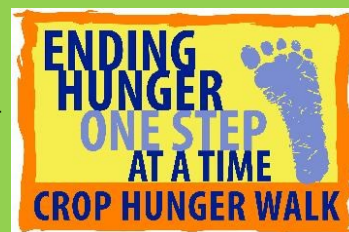
### Never packed a shoebox before?.
