Hurricane Relief in Rosharon, Texas

Last fall, within a few weeks of Hurricane Harvey last fall, Lake Shore sent a group of youth and adults to offer help. The group worked under the leadership of Butch Green, a CBF missionary, in a Cambodian fishing village. At Christmas some of you gave gift cards through our missions tree to help with the work. Here is a thank you and a report to Lake Shore from Butch:

I wanted to be sure and let you know that I received the gift cards from your church for the relief work. It will be a real blessings to have these to help towards supplies for people we are working with. I will be using most of them for a Cambodian couple in Rosharon. Their house was damaged during the hurricane predominately from leaks from the roof. The man had a stroke several years ago and is unable to work. She has had some medical issues as well. The house was pretty old and needs a lot of work. We will have to reroof it, put in all new electrical system and put sheetrock back up where it had to be removed. Your donations will really help with this family.

I have attached several photos of the couple and the house to give you an idea of the situation. Please pray for this family and their needs as we try to help them find a new sense of normal. Their names are Samuth and Dorn.
