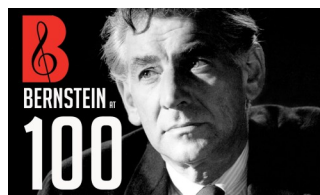

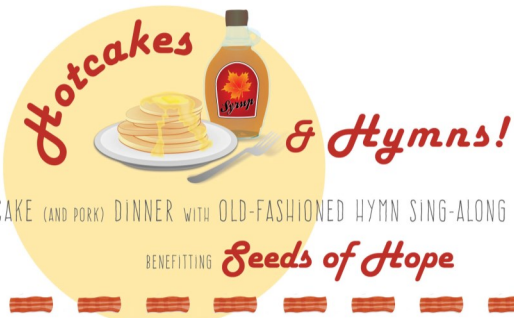
MissionKids is this Friday – May 4th
