When Dr. Hinojosa spoke at Lake Shore in mid-May, he explained the complicated humanitarian crisis of people leaving the Northern Triangle to come to the United States, but we had no idea how timely his visit with us would be.. Here's a chance to hear him in a different context as he and his colleagues talk to us about the journeys our neighbors make from Central America to the United States.

Victor J. Hinojosa is Associate Professor of Political Science in the Honors Program at Baylor University where he teaches courses in Political Science, the Honors Program, and in the Baylor Interdisciplinary Core. Dr. Hinojosa's primary research is in Latin American Politics and U.S.-Latin American relations.

Dr. Hinojosa currently directs the Baylor Migration Project, a social innovation laboratory at Baylor University, bringing together an interdisciplinary team of faculty and students to address the challenges of child migration from Mexico and the Northern Triangle (Guatemala, Honduras and El Salvador). In collaboration with the Texas Hunger Initiative, Mennonite Central Committee, and others Dr. Hinojosa and his students are working to design interventions into this challenging humanitarian crisis.

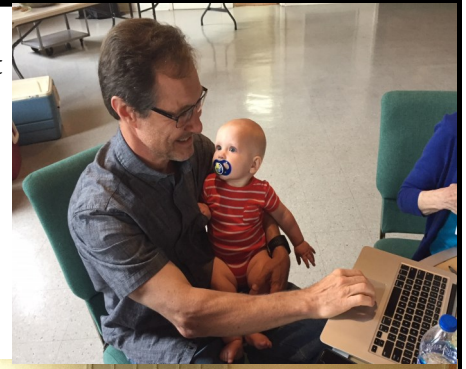

Gathering for Summer meals for Waco students

Craig Nash of THI told us about Red Oak, an apartment community that needs help this summer. It is a mixed-income property with a built-in summer and afterschool program (New Life Alliance). Because of its relatively remote location and small numbers of kids they serve (around 20), the school district can't serve them summer meals. They are looking for some help with shelf-stable food items that can be used to make meals for the summer program.



We hope you will pick up some items to fill their shelves and place them in the basket at the front door of the sanctuary through the summer. Here are some ideas:
