On Wednesday nights in September we will hear from individuals who serve the city of Waco every day by addressing our community's needs through their particular areas of expertise: healthcare, housing, immigration, hunger relief, education. They will help us better understand our city and recognize the needs within "Three 3 feet or so."

Milet Hopping is the President/CEO at Waco Housing Authority and Affiliates (WHA) where she has served 24 years. Her responsibilities include planning/operating the Housing Authority's three public housing sites and a Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher program that covers McLennan, Somervell and Hill County needs for those who need housing assistance payments to continue to live and work where they wish. Lake Shore has known Milet since Family Self-Sufficiency began.

**Team leader: Martie Sauter**

We need people to sort clothing donations (then hang them up in categories), fill in holes in clients' rooms and re-paint, weed whack and tidy up grounds at shelter, steam clean carpeted areas.

### **Gospel Café**

Clean the kitchen and the meeting house at the Gospel Café, a mission that serves about 200 lunches, free or at reduced cost, three days a week.

### **Habitat for Humanity**

### **Salvation Army**

Work inside and outside at Sally's House, a homeless shelter for families. We will deep clean the Salvation Army kitchen next door, weed flower beds and spruce up of the yard. Bring gloves.

### **Caritas**

Caritas of Waco is a non-profit organization whose primary mission is to eliminate hunger in McLennan County. We will work at the Hidden Treasures of Caritas thrift store on Bosque Boulevard. with clothes and others items which have been donated for sale there. Team members need to wear closed-toe shoes and bring work gloves. Sales at Hidden Treasures benefit the mission of Caritas.
