Baylor's STEPPIN' OUT program will be coming to LSBC on Saturday, November 10th from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. We are seeking eleven (11) or twelve (12) LSBC people willing to supervise one team of 10-12 students out of several Baylor student groups (approximately 100 students will be coming), who will be cleaning up and straightening up the inside and outside of LSBC Church, Teen House and outside areas. The Baylor student groups will be assigned tasks such as outside cleaning of the church and Teen House lawns, Peace Garden, and Labyrinth, sweeping the playground rubber material used in the equipment area, as well as working flower beds. Inside tasks will be cleaning the baseboard, walls, door frames, washing windows, moving things, cleaning the stage/choir loft area and Teen House. Tasks will be outlined for the supervisor in charge.

If two or three people could be lunch volunteers to set-up lunch for the students at noon, I would appreciate it. We will order pizzas; therefore, preparing the serving table and serving the students will be the major part of the tasks. Students and others will assist in cleaning up.

This is a wonderful and rewarding opportunity to work with and gain an understanding of our Baylor Students and promote LSBC. Each year, we give "God's kind of Love" to the BU Students and the BU students reciprocate. Last Spring, the BU Stepping Out students complimented LSBC: "We have been to many Steppin' Out events and Lake Shore is the first for us to feel your love, which we (BU) appreciate very much."

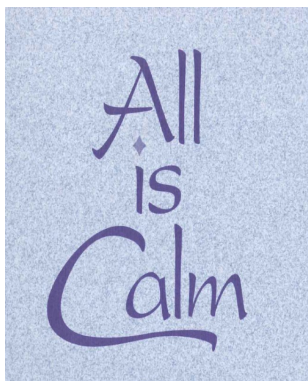

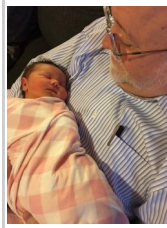
It's a Lake Shore tradition to create its own booklet of Advent meditations, a series of personal reflections written by

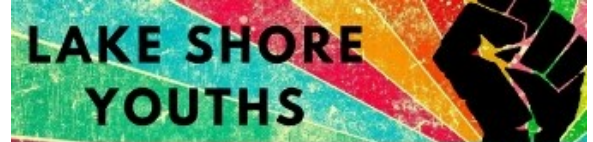
