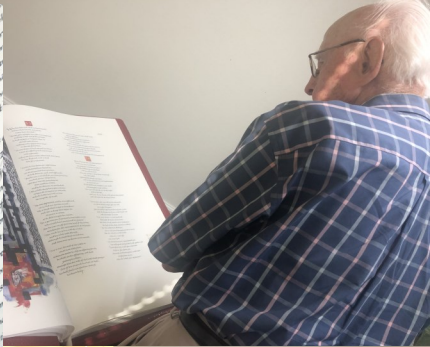
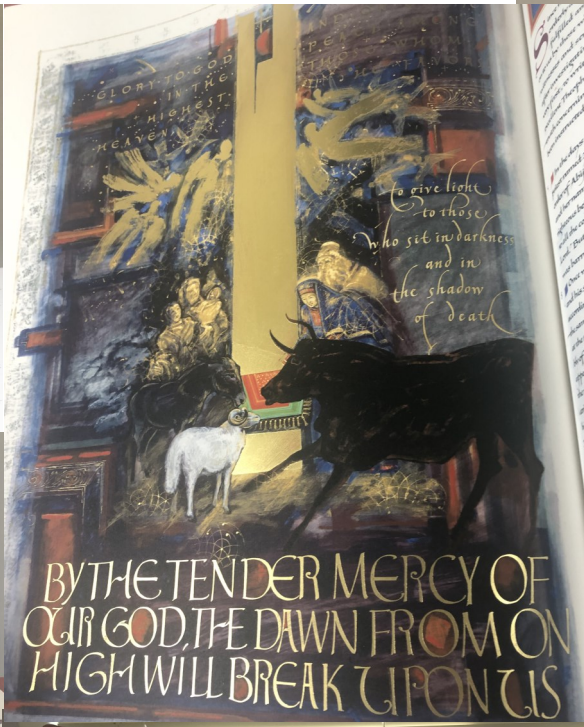
## Henry Clarke to Preach Sunday

Henry Clarke is a recent Waco transplant, having moved his software business here in the fall of 2017. He has been attending Lake Shore Baptist since July of last year and describes the first time coming to

With a diverse background in information technology and Christian ministry, Henry has had the unique opportunity to work and preach in the US and over a dozen other nations, including serving as the director of a mission in Guatemala for 5 years. He has also worked as both an executive and a development consultant for churches and large non-profit organizations assisting them in strategic management, organizational structure, and donor development.

**May, 2019 LSBC Financial Snapshot**

Here is the monthly topline picture of May results. Through five months, total revenue is up 2% and total expenses are down 4% relative to 2018.
