Rally For Refugees . . . and more

As you probably heard last week, Lake Shore raised

\$9,156 at our Rally for Refugees, with a possible \$545 to come. Our Global Missions Covenant Group had previously decided to split the money we raised between two non-profits. We also decided that people could designate gifts to either



American Gateways, that received \$4,364.50 or Semillas that received \$4,791.50.

Just a few hours before the dance at Lake Shore, Eric Howell, pastor of DaySpring, called to invite us to join four other churches in raising \$25,000 for a social worker, specializing in trauma care for Semillas. He wrote yesterday afternoon that \$28,051has been raised through all our gifts.

He said, "This will probably be my last update on this for now. I'm so very pleased at the responses and believe this could be the beginning of a beautiful partnership with John [Garland]. One of the fruits of this whole initiative is that Dennis and Tish Tucker, whom many of you know, have taken in a young woman and her 2 month old son. She is from Honduras, here in the asylum process. The 2 month old was born in San Antonio so he's a citizen of the US. It will probably be 6-9 months before we know the outcome of her case. She'll be living with the Tuckers during that time."

Thank you, Lake Shore friends, for engaging in this holy and healing work of God's kingdom.


"Finding God in the Faith of Others"
