Community through Caring (CTC) Groups

Upon joining Lake Shore, each individual or family at Lake Shore becomes a member of one of our Communities through Caring (CTC) groups. These groups expand the purpose of the Care Groups by making sure members get to know each other, not only by caring for each other in times of illness or loss but also by practicing habits of connection and friendship between church members who might not know each other in another way. The leaders' goals are to lead the group in:

- caring for each other in times of need and in times of celebrating good news together
