Family Education Committee Job Description

Composition:

The committee will be appointed by the Committee Coordinating Council. The committee will consist of six to nine committee members with three-year staggered terms, as well as one youth representative and one family representative. The committee will choose a vice-chair who will serve as chair in the next year's rotation.

Responsibility:

The committee is responsible for assisting with the planning and coordination of the Children, Youth, and Family programs, and the ministries of Lake Shore Baptist Church.

Duties:

- 1. To assist the Children, Youth, and Family Minister (henceforth referred to as CYF Minister) in determining priorities for Preschool through Youth religious education programs of the church.
- 2. To help the CYF Minister coordinate activities for all ages.
- 3. To assist and coordinate with the CYF Minister as a problem-solving/brainstorming group for families.
- 4. To plan and support parent/teacher educational opportunities with the goal of strengthening the relationships between children/youth, their families, and their teachers.
- 5. To determine and maintain policies with regards to programming, trips, and safety issues.
- 6. To help the CYF Minister by forming and submitting committee notes which will be shared with the Deacons through the Committee Coordinating Committee liaison.
- 7. To assist the CYF Minister with the budget for the CYF educational programs.
- 8. To assist the CYF Minister in selecting the appropriate Sunday School teachers and leaders for the classes and activities of the church.
- 9. To coordinate programs and support the interaction with the Lake Shore Children's Center so that the Preschool/Children's religious education program and the Children's Center function to benefit all the children served by the congregation.
- 10. To provide a medium for congregational feedback on the appropriateness of the religious education programs.
