

Lake Shore Baptist Church Position description Associate Minister of Faith Formation for Children and Youth

Status: Full-time (Salaried)

Principal Functions:

The minister will lead Lake Shore Baptist Church children and youth-- birth through high school age-- in a comprehensive program of Christian education and development. The minister will:

- Coordinate all religious education programs for children and youth-- birth through high school age.
- Act as a resource for parents and families, keeping in mind that the home should be the primary place for faith formation.
- Create safe spaces for the children and youth, in which they can develop in their own faith journeys.
- Assume primary responsibility for pastoral care for children and youth-- birth through high school age.
- Keep parents, children, youth, and the church body informed about all relevant activities.
- Participate as necessary with the pastoral staff in worship planning.
- Encourage children and youth involvement in the life of the church, such as through fellowship, worship, and service.

Position Responsibilities:

For Both Children and Youth

- Establish objectives for the children and youth program; work with the Family Education Committee in planning programs which meet the needs of children and their parents.
- Develop and lead the children and youth ministry, including Sunday School, mission activities, camps (grades 3 12), retreats, worship experiences, and fun activities.
- Plan/coordinate/facilitate Sunday morning curriculum for children and youth as well as the youth-only evening curriculum, emphasizing Christian foundations, Christian scriptures, spiritual formation, and contemporary applications.
- Provide education about baptism, communion, the church year, and stewardship of time, money, and talents/gifts.
- Recruit, schedule, and support Sunday School teachers of children and youth.
- Provide leadership and organize and maintain resources, curriculum, and training materials for Sunday School teachers, sponsors, and other lay leaders.
- Encourage children and youth participation in worship.
- Communicate at least weekly with children, youth, parents, and congregation about children and youth activities through the church website and Lake Shorelines.
- Provide pastoral care and support to children, youth, and their parents.
- Attend weekly staff meetings.
- Coordinate facility usage with the Children's Center.
- Assist in making recommendations, in collaboration with the Family Ed Committee, to the church budget for children and youth ministry.
- Engage in continuing education:
 - o Communicate and collaborate with other local ministries as appropriate.
 - o Continue reading books and articles and participating in webinars about human growth and development and the newest developments in preschool, children, and youth ministry.
 - o From time to time, participate in national in person conferences that focus on continuing education for youth and/children's ministry.

Specific to the Children's Program

- Coordinate children's time during worship.
- Coordinate Extended Care for preschoolers.

Specific to the Youth Program

- Facilitate Sunday evening activities.
- Create safe spaces for group discussion of the biblical narrative, explorations into Christian spirituality, and sharing life together.
- Plan activities and retreats with other local youth groups as appropriate.

Special agreements about PTO:

Eligible for one week of Continuing Education (as per Personnel Policies)

PTO: Part time
